## Monthly Men's prayer group:

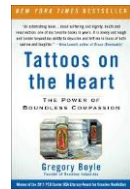

Sat., June 20 – **World Refugee Day (UN)**, 2026 Theme: "Until Everyone Is Safe"  
Commemorating the strength, courage and perseverance of millions of refugees forced to flee their home countries to escape conflict or persecution. [www.unhcr.org](http://www.unhcr.org)

Sunday, June 21, 2026 – **FATHER'S DAY**

June 21 – **Saint Aloysius Gonzaga** (1568-1591, Italy), Jesuit, Religious, Patron of young men, remembered in times of plague

June 22 – **Saint Mary Magdalene**, Disciple, referred to as the "Apostle of the Apostles," considered a paradigm of the ministry of women in the Church; Patron of converts, contemplative life and penitent sinners

June 22 – **Saints John Fisher & Thomas More**, Martyrs for rejecting Henry VIII's claim to be head of the Church in England

Saint John Fisher (1469-1535, England), Cardinal, Martyr

Saint Thomas More (1478-1535, England), lawyer, Martyr, Patron of lawyers, statesmen and politicians, defender of marriage, saint for those who have been widowed, orphans and adopted children, martyrs of conscience

Wed., June 24 – **Solemnity of the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist**, forerunner of the Messiah, preparing the Lord's coming not only by his preaching; Special patron of French Canadians

June 26 – **Saint Josemaría Escrivá de Balaguer** (1902-1975, Spain), priest, founder of Opus Dei and the Priestly Society of the Holy Cross

June 27 – **Saint Cyril of Alexandria** (376-444, Egypt), Bishop, Doctor of the Incarnation, held that the relationship between the divine and the human in Christ was so closely united that the Virgin was actually Theotokos, Mother of God

June 27 – **Our Lady of Perpetual Succour/Help** ("The Madonna of Saint Matthew"), icon, painted on wood, and seems to have originated around the thirteenth century; National Patroness of the Republic of Haiti

June 28 – **Saint Irenaeus of Lyons** (c.130- 202), Bishop, Martyr, Doctor of the Church, considered the first great Western ecclesiastical writer and theologian

June 29 – **Saints Peter and Paul**, Apostles, Martyred in Rome

- Saint Peter, born Simon, fisherman, chosen as one of Jesus' closest 12 apostles, "the rock" on which Jesus chose to build His Church, first Pope; Patron of fishermen, net makers, and ship builders

- Saint Paul, first named Saul, persecuted Christians, but had a powerful experience of Jesus and became a believer. He traveled far and preached to people who had never heard about Jesus and wrote letters that helped explain the teachings of the Church; Patron of authors, the press, publishers, and writers.

June 30 – **The First Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church**, the First Martyrs of the See of Rome, dedicated to the Christians martyred under the emperor Nero

Wed., July 1 – **Canada Day**

July 3 – **Saint Thomas**, the Apostle of India, the twin, doubting Thomas; Patron of builders, India & Pakistan

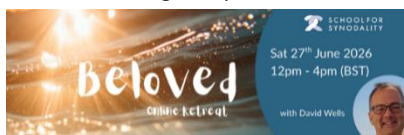
