

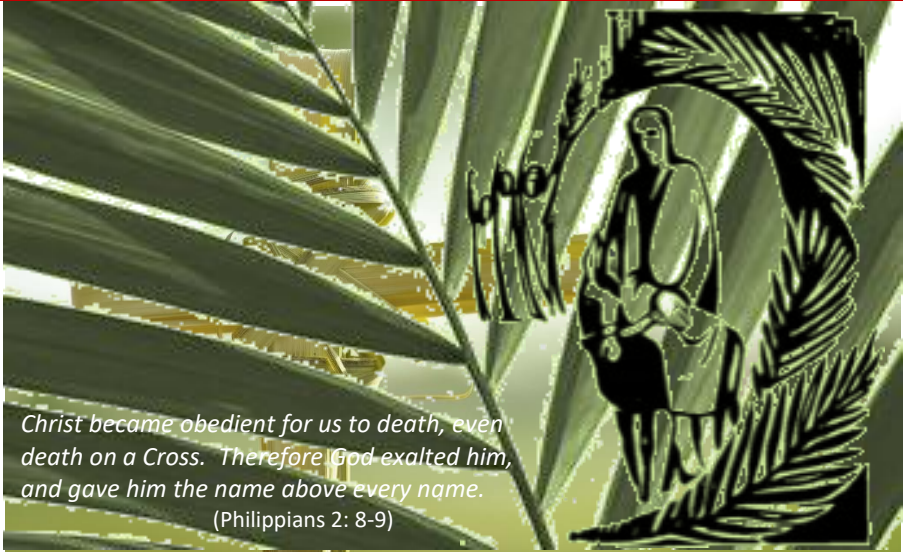

# ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.



All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence (no meat).

Catholics aged 18-60 are required to fast on Good Friday.

**THE PASCHAL FAST:** Good Friday and Holy Saturday are days of prayer & quiet reflection, honouring the suffering and death of Jesus and preparing to share in the joy of his resurrection at Easter.  
(*Living Lent*, CCCB ca)

April 2 – **Saint Francis of Paola**, Hermit, founder of the Franciscan Order of Minim Friars, Prophet, Miracle worker, Patron of sailors, naval officers, navigators, all those people associated with the sea

April 4 – **Saint Isidore of Seville**, Archbishop, Doctor of the Church, teacher, founder, reformer, required seminaries in every diocese, wrote a rule for religious orders, prolific writer whose works include a dictionary, an etymological encyclopedia that assembled extracts of many books from classical antiquity that would have otherwise been lost, a few histories, invented the comma, the colon and the full stop period; Patron of computer users and technicians, the Internet, students

April 5 – **Saint Vincent Ferrer**, Dominican Friar, he worked so hard to build up the Church that he became the patron of people in building trades.
