ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

May is the month dedicated to Mary – During this month Christians, both in church and in the privacy of the home, offer up to Mary from their hearts an especially fervent and loving homage of prayer and veneration. In this month, too, the benefits of God's mercy come down to us from her throne in greater abundance.

May 19 – **Saint Yves (Ivo) of Kermartin**, lawyer, Franciscan, priest, preacher, peacemaker/arbiter and miracle worker; Patron of abandoned people, advocates, Brittany, canonists, jurists, orphans, Worshipful Company of Solicitors

May 20 – **Saint Bernadine of Siena**, priest, Franciscan Friar Minor, charismatic itinerant preacher, theological writer; Patron in all areas of speaking, advertising, communications personnel, public relations, against hoarseness, respiratory problems, compulsive gamblers

Monday, May 20, **MARY MOTHER OF THE CHURCH** -----

May 21 – **Saint Christopher Magallanes and Companions**, Martyrs of the Mexican Revolution

May 21 – **Saint Eugène de Mazenod**, Bishop, formed the Missionaries of Provence who conducted parish missions in America, South Africa and Asia, later renamed the Congregation of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate; Patron of dysfunctional families

May 22 – **Saint Rita of Cascia**, Religious, Augustinian; Patron of desperate, seemingly impossible causes and situations

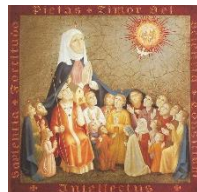
May 24 – **World Day of Prayer for the Church in China**

MARY, HELP OF CHRISTIANS -----

(Shrine of Sheshan in Shanghai)

May 24 – **Blessed Louis-Zéphérin Moreau**, Bishop, founded the Union of Saint Joseph, the Sisters of Saint-Joseph of Saint-Hyacinthe, and the Sisters of Sainte-Martha, helped establish the forerunners of today's mutual societies and credit unions.

May 25 – **Saint Bede the Venerable**, Benedictine (O.S.B.), monk, Priest, Doctor of the Church, Father of English history, his Ecclesiastical History of the English People provides the best information on England in the early middle-ages
