

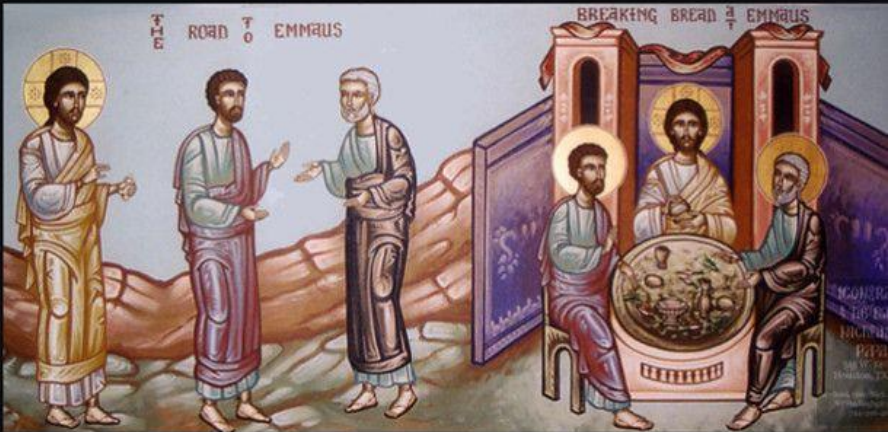

ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

April 22 – **Earth Day**, on which we demonstrate support for environmental protection (EarthDay.org)

April 23 – **Saint George**, Martyr, immortalised in the myth of Saint George and the Dragon where he embodied chivalrous behavior (protecting women, fighting evil, dependence on faith and might of arms, largesse to the poor). Patron of England, of the boy scouts, of knights and soldiers, and many other countries, cities, professions; one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers.

April 23 – **Saint Adalbert of Prague**, Benedictine, Bishop, Martyr, 'Apostle of the Slavs'. Patron of Bohemia, Czech Republic, Poland and Prague

Monday, April 24 – **anniversary of the Armenian Genocide**

Armenians recognise this tragedy, by dimming the lights in their homes and lighting candles on the eve of the night before, at 9 pm, in memory of the Holy Martyrs of the Genocide. Simultaneously, bells toll in local Armenian churches. Then, on the feast day itself, April 24, at 12 noon, they observe one minute of silence and church bells will toll again for three minutes.

April 24 – **Saint Fidelis of Sigmaringen**, Capuchin Franciscan friar, Martyr, preacher. Patron of lawyers

April 25 – **Saint Mark Evangelist**, author of the earliest and shortest gospel, often depicted with a winged lion, patron of notaries, Egypt and Venice

Tuesday, April 25 – **MAJOR ROGATION**, known in England as "Gang Days" and "Cross Week", and in Germany as Bittage, Bittwoche, or Kreuzwoche, this is a day of prayer and abstinence from meat, observed with processions and the Litany of the Saints, instituted by the Church to appease God's anger at man's transgressions, to ask protection from calamities, and to obtain a good and bountiful harvest.

April 26 – **Our Lady of Good Counsel**, Patron of the Catholic Women's League of Canada (CWL Day of Peace and Hope)

April 27 – **Saint Zita**, domestic servant, often gave her own food, and sometimes that of her master, to those poorer than herself. Patron: housekeeping, against losing keys, domestic servants, people ridiculed for their piety, rape victims, single laywomen, waitstaff

April 28 – **Saint Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort**, Priest, Dominican, founded the Daughters of Divine Wisdom and the Brothers of Saint Gabriel, devoted to the care of the destitute, founded the Company of Mary or Montfort Missionaries, great apostle of the Rosary by means his miraculously inspiring book, *The Secret of the Rosary*, and the Total Consecration to the Blessed Virgin.

April 28 – **Saint Gianna Beretta Molla**, mother of four, pediatrician, risked her own health for her baby's in the womb
