**ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR**

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

May 8 – **Blessed Catherine of Saint Augustine**, Religious of the Augustinian Hospital Sisters of the Mercy of Jesus, mystic, remembered for the kindness and great love for the people, among the cofounders of the Canadian church

May 10 – **Saint John of Avila**, priest, author, and mystic, sometimes called the “Apostle of Andalusia” because of his extensive ministry to that area, doctor of the Church prominent in 16th century Catholic Reformation

May 10 – **Saint Dyfan (Saint Damian of Molokai)** Martyr, 2nd century missionary to the Britons sent by the pope at the request of the king

May 11 – **Saint Mamertus**, Archbishop, miracle worker, known for his learning and for bringing back the faith to an indifferent region

May 12 – **Saint Nereus and Saint Achilleus**, brothers, martyrs, household servants of the noble lady Saint Flavia Domitilla

May 12 – **Saint Pancras**, orphan, martyr, Patron of children and adolescents

May 12 – **Blessed Imelda Lambertini**, while still a child, she put together a little oratory in her house, and spent much time there in prayer, she felt drawn to religious life, and planned to become a nun, on 12 May, 1333, she miraculously received her First Communion, and immediately after died in an ecstasy of love and joy, Patroness of First Communicants

May 12 – **Saint Leopold Mandic**, Capuchin, Apostle of the Confession, Apostle of Unity, contrasted physical frailty with spiritual strength, his humility and faith in God enabled him to accept his poor physical condition, and realize God's power

May 13 – **Our Lady of Fatima**, recognising the first appearance of the Blessed Virgin Mary to 3 shepherd children, at Fátima, Portugal.
