WARDENS' ELECTIONS

The Council of Wardens has called for a meeting of Parishioners, **next Sunday, January 11, 2026, at 11pm**, in the Church, **to elect one (1) warden** for the statutory 3-year term of 2026-29.

What is a Warden?

The role of the Council of Wardens is defined by the Civil Code of Quebec (see: www.legisquebec.gouv.qc.ca/en/document/cs/F-1). According to the Code, the Wardens are the administrators of the finances, material goods and property intended for the religious benefit of Parishioners. They are elected by the Parishioners at a meeting called for that purpose by parishioners who live within the geographical boundaries of the Parish (Ste.-Anne-de-Bellevue, Baie d'Urfé, Senneville).

Candidates must be aged 18 years or older, be nominated by two Parishioners at the meeting called for that purpose, and must live within the geographical boundaries of the Parish (Ste.-Anne-de-Bellevue, Baie d'Urfé, Senneville). The lengths of terms for the open positions are shown above. Wardens may serve a second term, if elected.

Some of the attributes required of a Warden are:

- a sense of the Mission of Christ;
- some administrative skills;
- practical common sense.



If you are interested in becoming a Warden, or if there is someone you would like to nominate, please indicate this interest to Wally Rowcliffe, to Fr. Stephen or any one of the Wardens. Their names and contact information are shown on the Bulletin.

ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

January is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus

celebrated January 3, the feast commemorates the naming of the child Jesus; as recounted in the Gospel: "at the end of eight days, when he was circumcised, he was called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived"

Jan. 4 – **Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton**, wife, mother of 5, convert, first person born in what is now the USA to be canonized, established the first Catholic girls' school in the nation, initiating the parochial school system in America, where she also founded the first American congregation of religious sisters, the Sisters of Charity,

Jan. 7 – **Saint Brother André Besette**, brother of the Congregation of the Holy Cross, envisioned and spearheaded the construction of Saint Joseph's Oratory on Mount Royal, patron of family caregivers in Canada

Jan. 8 – **Saint Apollinaris the Apologist**, held in high regard by other early saints, worked and wrote against all the major heresies of his time, refuting them by logically destroying the heresy's philosophical roots, prolific writer, most of his work has been lost over the centuries

Jan. 9 – **Saint William of Bourges**, Cistercian Monk, Abbot and Archbishop, lived an austere life, defended clerical rights against the state, cared personally for the poor, sick, imprisoned and debauched, and converted many Albigensians in his diocese to orthodox Christianity, miracle worker

Jan. 9 – **Saint Eulogius of Cordoba**, priest, Martyr, head of an ecclesiastical school, comforted and supported Christian martyrs and their survivors during Islamic persecutions in Moorish occupied Spain, arrested several times for his faith

The Jubilee Year of Hope ends on Epiphany, Tuesday, January 6, 2026, with the closing of the Holy Doors in Rome.

We continue and will complete our ongoing examination "the Nicene Creed Explained" in the bulletin this month.
