ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

February is devoted to the Holy Family

Feb. 21 – **Saint Peter Damian**, Benedictine, monk, Cardinal Bishop of Ostia, Doctor, key reformer, sought to restore and reform order among priests and religious houses by revitalizing Church zeal and clerical discipline addressing widespread excesses and grave sins, he advised seven popes, traveled to many places representing the Holy Father working with priests, bishops, kings, and emperors.

Feb. 23 – **Saint Polycarp of Smyrna**, Bishop, Martyr, convert and disciple of Saint John the Apostle, friend of Saint Ignatius of Antioch and Saint Papias; spiritual teacher of Saint Irenaeus of Lyon. Fought Gnosticism. One of the Fathers of the early Church, extremely influential in the catechesis and initiation of new Christians

Feb. 25 – **OUR LADY OF GREAT POWER**, through the Ursulines in Quebec, the devotion soon spread through the New World (Quebec, Canada)

W-F-Sat, Feb. 25, 27, 28 – Lenten Ember Days / spring Embertide

symbolized by the Paschal and baptismal candle, marked with prayer, fasting and abstinence, stressing spiritual renewal; set aside to thank God for the sacraments and pray for priests. A time to ask blessings on the upcoming growing season; offered in thanksgiving with flowers, which feed the bees, who make the wax that gives us altar candles, and ultimately the gift of light. Flowers were presented and blessed on Ember Wednesday

Feb. 26 – **Saint Irene**, convert, saved Saint Porphyrius from a mob abusing for him for his faith

Feb. 27 – **Saint Gregory of Narek (Grigor)**, Monk, poet, mystical philosopher, theologian, Doctor of the Universal Church, many of his prayers are included in the Divine Liturgy celebrated each Sunday in Armenian Churches around the world, best known for his Book of Lamentations, a major piece of mystical literature, which has a theme of man's separation from God, and his quest to reunite with Him; it has been translated into at least 30 languages

Feb. 28 – **Pope Saint Hilarius (Hilary)**, 46th Pope, worked on an updated method of calculating the date of Easter, confirmed the work of several general councils, rebuilt and remodeled many churches, fought Nestorianism and Arianism, and held several Councils at Rome, renowned for defending the rights of his bishops while exhorting them to curb their excesses and devote themselves more completely to God, helped define the Church's role in the empire, and affirmed the position of the pope, and not the emperor, as leader in spiritual matters, erected churches, convents, libraries, and two public baths, and his synod of 465 is the earliest Roman synod whose records are extant

Feb. 25, 2026 – **Pink Shirt Day (CANADA)** – inspires us to raise awareness of the issues of bullying as a major problem in our schools, homes, workplaces and online and to raise funds to support anti-bullying programs www.pinkshirtday.ca


