ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

Jan. 8 – **St Raymond of Penyafort**, Dominican priest, codifier of Canon Law

Jan. 8 – **St Apollinaris the Apologist**, prolific writer held in high regard by other early saints, worked and wrote against all the major heresies of his time, refuting them by logically destroying the heresy's philosophical roots, most of his work has been lost over time

Jan. 9 – **St William of Bourges**, Cistercian Monk, Abbot and Archbishop, lived an austere life, defended clerical rights against the state, cared personally for the poor, sick, imprisoned and debauched, and converted many Albigensians in his diocese to orthodox Christianity, miracle worker

Jan. 9 – **St Eulogius of Cordoba**, priest, martyr, head of an ecclesiastical school, comforted and supported Christian martyrs and their survivors during Islamic persecutions in Moorish occupied Spain, arrested several times for his faith, wrote Exhortation to Martyrdom

Jan. 11 – **St Hyginus**, Pope during a period of relative peace with no official persecutions of the early Church, forced to deal with a series of heretic sects and preachers regularly popping up

Jan. 12 – **St Marguerite Bourgeoys**, Religious, foundress of the uncloistered Congregation of Notre Dame de Montreal (CND), who helped people in the colony survive when food was scarce, opened vocational schools, taught young people how to run a home and farm, they opened missions and started schools, instructing children, educating young girls, the poor, and natives, and preparing young women as Christian teachers, played an important role in the construction of Montreal's first chapel, Notre-Dame-de-Bon-Secours, first Canadian Saint.

Jan. 13 – **St Hilary of Poitiers**, Bishop, Doctor of the Divinity of Christ, as he studied the Bible for the first time, he literally read himself into the faith, his teaching and writings converted many, he introduced Eastern theology to the Western Church, fought Arianism, called the Athanasius of the West
