ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

Sunday, April 3 – Beginning of PASSIONTIDE

The fifth Sunday of Lent is also known as "Carling Sunday" in England since carlin peas (*cajanus cajanwas* – a small, hard brown pea known by many other names, such as; Maple Peas, Pigeon Peas, Brown Peas and Black or Grey Badgers) are a traditional northern food eaten during lent on Passion Sunday, the Sunday before Palm Sunday.

April 2 – **Saint Francis of Paola**, Hermit, founder of the Franciscan Order of Minim Friars, prophet, miracle worker, Patron saint of sailors, naval officers, navigators, and all people associated with the sea

April 2 – **POPE SAINT JOHN PAUL II DAY** (Canada)

April 4 – **Saint Isidore of Seville**, Archbishop, Doctor of the Church, teacher, founder, reformer, required seminaries in every diocese, prolific writer whose works include a dictionary, an encyclopedia and histories, Patron of computers, the Internet, computer technicians and users, schoolchildren, students

April 5 – **Saint Vincent Ferrer**, Dominican Friar, he worked so hard to build up the Church that he became the patron of people in building trades.

April 7 – **Saint John Baptist de la Salle**, priest, father of modern education, founded the Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools (Christian Brothers), patron of all teachers, youth, educators and principals
