ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

August 13 – **Saint Pontian**, Pope, Martyr, ended the schism of Hippolytus and reconciled the schismatics with the Church

and Saint Hippolytus, priest, Martyr, important theologian, prolific writer described the Roman liturgy and the structure of the early Church, wrote scripture commentaries, polemics against heresies and a history of the world

August 13 – BI. Michael J. McGivney, priest, founded the Knights of Columbus

August 14 – Saint Maximilian Kolbe, Franciscan, Priest, Martyr

August 15, THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

We proclaim the divinely revealed truth that the Immaculate Mother of God on the completion of her earthly life was assumed body and soul into heaven. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended. In an age of sensuality and materialism, the Assumption points out the dignity and destiny of our human body, extols the dignity of womanhood, and turns our eyes to the true life beyond the grave.

August 19 – **Saint John Eudes**, Priest, founded the Congregation of Jesus and Mary (Eudists), the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity (parent body of the Good Shepherd nuns), great promoter of the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary

August 20 – **Saint Bernard of Clairvaux**, Cistercian, Abbot, Mellifluous Doctor of the Church because of his eloquence, advisor to popes and kings, helped organize the Second Crusade

August 21 – **Saint Pius X**, Pope, advocated for frequent Communion, reformed the liturgy, revised the Breviary, promoted clear and simple homilies, fought Modernism, reorganized the Roman curia, initiated the codification of canon law, promoted Bible reading by all the faithful

21 August – International Day of Remembrance and Tribute to Victims of Terrorism (UN)

August 22 – THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Jesus is King throughout all eternity by nature and by right of conquest; through Him, with Him, and subordinate to Him, Mary is Queen by grace, by divine relationship, by right of conquest, and by singular election. Her kingdom is as vast as that of her Son and God, since nothing is excluded from her dominion.

22 August – International Day Commemorating Victims of Acts of Violence Based on Religion or Belief (UN)

August 23 – **Saint Rose of Lima**, Dominican, mystic/visionary, received invisible stigmata, first canonised Saint born in the Americas

August 24 – **Saint Bartholomew**, apostle, Martyr; probably a close friend of Saint Philip, may have preached in Asia Minor, Ethiopia, India and Armenia

August 25 – **Saint Louis IX**, King of France, father to eleven children, established religious foundations, aided mendicant orders and built leper hospitals, led two Crusades and died on one

August 25 – **Saint Joseph Calasanz**, Priest, founded the Order of Poor Clerks Regular of the Mother of God of the Pious Schools (Piarists)
