JULY IS DEDICATED TO THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF CHRIST

Sunday, July 10 - SEA SUNDAY

A day for Christians to remember seafarers and pray for them, their families, and those who support them. Particularly recognized in cities with major ports like Montreal which undertake various pastoral and social service programs to assist seafarers. They are assisted by churches, charities such as the Apostleship of the Sea, The Mission to Seafarers and the Sailors' Society, and non-denominational groups such as Sea Cadets. We especially think about and thank those seafarers who work tirelessly throughout the year bringing us goods we often take for granted.
