ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

April 21 – **GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY – WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS**

The Fourth Sunday of Easter, Christians are invited to reflect on the meaning of God's call and to pray for the vocations. Christ, the Good Shepherd, continues to lead his people through His Bishops, Priests, and Deacons, and calls many to follow Him in this way. Priestly, diaconal and religious vocations should be a constant concern in the hearts of God's people. (CCCB, ORDO)

April 21 – **Saint Anselm of Canterbury**, Benedictine monk, Archbishop, Doctor of the Church for Scholasticism and Marian Doctor, called "Magnificent doctor", one of the great philosophers and theologians of the middle ages, noted theological writer.

April 22-30 – **PESACH/PASSOVER**

April 22 – **Earth Day**, on which we demonstrate support for environmental protection

April 23 – **Saint George**, Martyr, immortalised in the myth of Saint George and the Dragon where he embodied chivalrous behavior (protecting women, fighting evil, dependence on faith and might of arms, largesse to the poor), Patron of England, boy scouts, knights, soldiers, and many other countries, cities & professions; one of the 14 Holy Helpers.

April 23 – **Saint Adalbert of Prague**, Benedictine, Bishop, Martyr, "Apostle of the Slavs", Patron of Bohemia, Czech Republic, Poland and Prague

April 25 – **Saint Mark Evangelist**, author of the earliest and shortest gospel, often depicted with a winged lion, Patron of notaries, Egypt and Venice

April 26 – **Our Lady of Good Counsel**, Patron of the Catholic Women's League of Canada

April 27 – **Saint Zita**, domestic servant, often gave her own food, and sometimes that of her master, to those poorer than herself, Patron of housekeeping, against losing keys, domestic servants, people ridiculed for their piety, rape victims, single laywomen, waitstaff

Thursday April 25 – **MAJOR ROGATION**, a day of prayer and fasting, the practice of the Church was to offer prayers to the Lord for the needs of all people, especially for the productivity of the earth and for human labour, to ask protection from calamities and to make public thanksgiving during the spring planting season. It was traditional, on the major rogation day, for the congregation to walk in procession around the boundaries of the parish, blessing every tree, stone and crop, while chanting or reciting a Litany of Mercy, usually a Litany of the Saints."
