## Results of Wardens' Election Held on November 27, 2022

Last Sunday, November 27, 2022, following 10am Mass, a meeting of parishioners was held to elect Wardens to replace those whose mandates had expired or were about to expire.

The constraints of the government regulations applied during the COVID19 pandemic lockdowns did not allow for a meeting of parishioners to elect Wardens to replace the three Wardens whose mandates had expired during that period. The Law, nevertheless, did allow for those Wardens to stay in office until replaced. The mandates of two other Wardens will expire on December 30, 2022. One seat was vacant. Therefore, all six seats were open for election. The length of the mandates of Wardens elected was determined to satisfy the requirements of the Fabrique Law which stipulates that two Wardens seats must be up for election each year. Their mandates will begin on January 1, 2023 and ends on December 30 of the years indicated below. **Elected were:**

## ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

Dec. 3 – **St Francis Xavier**, Jesuit Priest, one of the founding Jesuits and the first Jesuit missionary, Apostle to the Far East

Dec. 4 – **St John Damascene**, Priest, Doctor of the Church for Christian Art, last of the Greek Fathers, such an excellent speaker he was known as *Chrysorrhoeas* (“golden-stream”), defended the use of icons, wrote a compendium of Christian theology and works defending the orthodox faith, commentaries on Saint Paul the Apostle, poetry, and hymns, adapted choral music for use in the liturgy

Dec. 6 – **St Nicholas of Myra**, Bishop, generous to the poor, special protector of the innocent and wronged, many stories grew around him prior to his becoming associated with Santa Claus.



Dec. 6 – **NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE AND ACTION ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN** (in remembrance of the 14 young women assassinated at the Ecole Polytechnique de Montreal, in 1989)

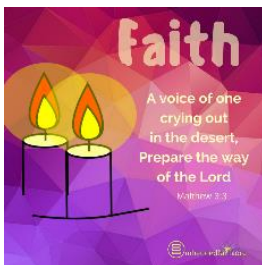
Dec. 7 – **St Ambrose of Milan**, Bishop, Doctor of the Church for his speaking and preaching ability, Father of the church, one of the four original Doctors of the Latin Church along with St. Augustine, St. Jerome, and Pope St. Gregory I

Dec. 8 – **Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, "From the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Saviour of the human race, the most Blessed Virgin Mary was preserved immune from all stain of original sin." — Catechism of the Catholic Church, principal Patron of the Ecclesiastical province of Montréal

Dec. 9 – **St Juan Diego Cuauhtlatotzin**, chosen to receive the Guadalupe apparition of Mary at Tepeyac, Mexico (December 13, 1531). Our Lady left a marvelous portrait of herself on his mantle as a sign for his Bishop

Dec. 10 – **Our Lady of Loreto**, refers to the Shrine of the Holy House at Loreto, the house in which Mary was born, and where the Annunciation occurred, Patron of people involved in aviation, builders, construction workers

Dec. 10 – **St Melchisedes**, Pope, Martyr, ruled the Church of God in the last period of the Christian persecution from 311-314; hence the title of martyr is applied to him in a wider sense, witnessed the beginning of an era of peace when in 312 the Emperor Constantine granted freedom to the Church



The second purple candle on the Advent wreath represents Faith and is often called the “Bethlehem Candle”. This candle reminds us of Mary and Joseph’s journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem before Mary gave birth to Jesus. It also builds on the meaning of the first candle, the Prophecy Candle, recalling that after the division, destruction and dispersion of the kingdom of the Old Testament, we have faith that there might finally be peace on Earth.
