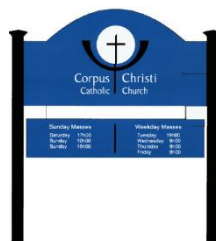

ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

AUGUST is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Saturday, August 15 – Solemnity, **THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**
special patron of Acadians

August 16 – **Saint Stephen of Hungary**, (c. 975-1038), King, encouraged the spread of Christianity in Hungary and consolidated the Christian hold on the region, helped build churches, established bishoprics and Benedictine monasteries

August 19 – **Saint John Eudes**, (1601-1680; France), Priest, Founded the Congregation of Jesus and Mary (*Eudists*) and the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity (parent body of the Good Shepherd nuns), great promoter of the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus & the Immaculate Heart of Mary; Patron: Diocese of Baie-Comeau, missionaries

August 20 – **Saint Bernard of Clairvaux**, (1090-1153; France), priest, Abbot, Mellifluous Doctor of the Church because of his eloquence, founder of the Cistercians, a reform order of the Benedictines, advisor of popes and kings, supported the invention of the Christian knight by endorsing the Knights Templar, helped organize the Second Crusade, strong advocate of devotion to Our Lady, and of orthodox doctrine

August 21 – **Saint Pius X**, (1835-1914; Italy), Pope, restored taking Holy Communion from age 7 (instead of at 12 or 14 as was done at the time), destroyed the last vestiges of Jansenism by advocating frequent and even daily Communion, reformed the liturgy, promoted clear and simple homilies, revised the Breviary and teaching of the Catechism, fought the evils of Modernism, which he denounced as “the summation of all heresies”, reorganized the Roman curia and the other administrative elements of the Church; initiated the codification of canon law; promoted Bible reading by all the faithful

21 Aug. – **International Day of Remembrance & Tribute to the Victims of Terrorism (UN)**

22 Aug. – **International Day Commemorating the Victims of Acts of Violence Based on Religion or Belief (UN)**

Saturday, August 22 – **THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

August 23 – **Saint Rose of Lima**, (1586-1617; Peru), Dominican, mystic/visionary, received invisible stigmata, first canonised saint born in the Americas; Patron: Latin America, the Philippines

August 24 – **Saint Bartholomew**, apostle, Martyr; probably a close friend of Saint Phillip, may have preached in Asia Minor, Ethiopia, India and Armenia, leaving behind assorted writings including a possible gospel, now lost, mentioned in other writings of the time

August 25 – **Saint Louis IX**, (1214 – 1270; France), King of France; father to eleven children; promoted Christianity in France; established religious foundations; aided mendicant orders; propagated synodal decrees of the Church; built leper hospitals; collected relics; led two Crusades and died on one

August 25 – **Saint Joseph Calasanaz (Calasanctius)**, (1557-1648; Spain) Priest, founded the Order of Poor Clerks Regular of the Mother of God of the Pious Schools (*Piarists*) a community of teaching priests; Patron: Schools

August 27 – **Saint Monica**, (331-387; Algeria, Italy) wife, mother of 3 including St. Augustine of Hippo, reformed alcoholic, Patron: mothers & married women, abuse victims, alcoholics, difficult marriages, disappointing children, homemakers, victims of unfaithfulness, widows

August 28 – **Saint Augustine of Hippo**, (354-430; Algeria, Italy), Bishop, Father of the Church, Doctor of Grace (Doctor gratiae), one of the four original Doctors of the Latin Church, founded religious communities, fought Manichaeism, Donatism, Pelagianism and other heresies, oversaw his church and his see during the fall of the Roman Empire to the Vandals. His later thinking can also be summed up in a line from his writings: *Our hearts were made for You, O Lord, and they are restless until they rest in you.*

August 28 – **Saint Junipero Serra**, (1713-1784; Spain – California), Franciscan, missionary, penitent and austere in all areas of his life, founded and responsible for many missions in the Mexican provinces of Lower and Upper California; Patron of California, for those discerning their vocation, the Serra Club (an international Catholic organization dedicated to the promotion of vocations, and the support of seminarians and religious novices)
