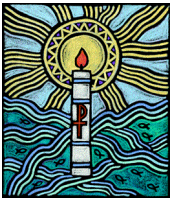

July 24, 2022 – World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

"In old age they will still bear fruit" (Psalm 92:15)

The 2nd World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated throughout the universal Church next weekend. The theme emphasizes how grandparents and the elderly are a value and a gift for families, society, and ecclesial communities. It is also an invitation to reconsider and value grandparents and the elderly who are too often kept on the margins of families, and civil and ecclesial communities. Their experience of life and faith can contribute, in fact, to building societies that are aware of their roots and capable of dreaming of a future based on greater solidarity. To underline the importance of listening to the wisdom of the years, Pope Francis has instituted a plenary indulgence, under the usual conditions, for all those who participate in liturgical celebrations observing the day, those who unite themselves spiritually to those celebrations if they are unable to leave their homes, and those who visit, in person or virtually, their grandparents or elderly brothers and sisters in need.

ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

JULY IS DEDICATED TO THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD OF CHRIST

We encourage you to take time to adore Our Lord in your parish. The Beloved waits for you in the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle, which contains the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Devotion to the Holy Eucharist is devotion to the Blood of Christ. In Eucharistic adoration, we are adoring the Blood of Christ, also contained in the sacred Host.

"To adore Me is to demonstrate that all your hope is in Me. To adore Me is to show Me that you count not on yourself nor on others, but on Me alone.

To adore Me is to give Me the freedom to act within you and upon you in such a way as to unite you wholly to myself as you have asked Me to do: My Heart to your heart, My Soul to your soul, My Body to your body, My Blood to your blood."

July 16 – **Our Lady of Mont Carmel**, feast of the brown scapular, principal feast day of the Order of Carmel (Carmelites)

July 18 – **Saint Symphorosa and her seven sons**, Martyrs

July 20 – **Saint Apollinaris of Ravenna**, Bishop, one of the first great Martyrs, mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles, spiritual student of Saint Peter the Apostle

July 20 – **Ste Margaret of Antioch**, Virgin, Martyr, one of the "Fourteen Holy Helpers", among the saints that appeared and spoke to Ste Joan of Arc, Patron of exiles, against sterility, expectant & nursing mothers, nurses, falsely accused people, kidney disease, women in labour

July 21 – **Saint Lawrence of Brindisi**, Capuchin Franciscan, Priest, diplomat, missionary, Doctor of the Church

July 22 – **Ste Mary Magdalene**, faithful disciple of Jesus, first witness of the resurrection of Christ, patron of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans)

July 23 – **Ste Bridget of Sweden**, mother, Franciscan tertiary, Cistercian Religious, founded the Order of the Most Holy Savior (Bridgettines), mystic, visionary with gifts of prophecy and healing, patron of widows and Sweden, co-patron of Europe

July 24 – **Saint Sharbel Makhlūf (Charbel Makhlouf)**, Maronite hermit, priest

July 25 – **Feast of Saint James "the Greater"**, apostle, brother of John the Evangelist, "sons of thunder", fishermen, patron of Spain and of pilgrims

July 25 – **Saint Christopher**, one of the "Fourteen Sainted Helpers," highly venerated in both the Eastern and Western Churches, patron of bachelors, motorists, Croatia, sailors, transportation workers; travellers, watermen

July 26 – **Feast of Ste Anne & Saint Joachim**, parents of the Virgin Mary

July 29 – **Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus of Bethany**, friends of Jesus, Martha: model of hospitality and fidelity in discipleship, patron of domestic workers and cooks; together they are patrons of siblings

July 30 – **Saint Peter Chrysologus**, Bishop, preacher called "Golden-Worded" because of his inspirational homilies, Doctor of the Church for the strength of his beautiful explanations of the Incarnation, the Creed, the place of Mary and John the Baptist in the great plan of salvation
