ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

July 30 – **Saint Peter Chrysologus**, Bishop, preacher called "Golden-Worded" because of his inspirational homilies, Doctor of the Church for the strength of his beautiful explanations of the Incarnation, the Creed, the place of Mary and John the Baptist in the great plan of salvation

July 31 – **Saint Ignatius of Loyola**, priest, founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits), developed the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises, Patron of retreats and soldiers

August 1 – **Saint Alphonsus Maria de Liguori**, Bishop, founder of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Liguorians, Redemptorists), Doctor *Zelantissimus* ("Most Zealous Doctor"), patron of moral theologians and confessors

August 2 – **Saint Pierre-Julien (Peter Julian) Eymard**, Priest, mystic, founder of the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament, the lay Servants of the Blessed Sacrament

August 4 – **Saint Jean-Baptiste Marie Vianney**, Curé of Ars-en-Dombes, renowned confessor, Patron of parish priests

August 5 – **Blessed Frédéric Janssoone**, Franciscan, negotiated for and built stations, churches, and sanctuaries in Jerusalem and helped develop the Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Rosary (Notre-Dame-du-Cap) near Trois-Rivières

August 5 – **Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major**, Rome (the Liberian Basilica)

August 7 – **Saint Cajetan**, Priest, founded the Congregation of Clerks Regular (Thetines),

August 8 – **Saint Dominic de Guzman**, Priest, founded the Order of Friars Preachers (Dominicans), Patron of the Dominican Republic, astronomers, scientists and the falsely accused

August 8 – **The Fourteen Holy Helpers** – Saints invoked with special confidence in the past because they proved themselves efficacious helpers in adversity and difficulties (feast dropped after Vatican II): Acacius of Byzantium, Barbara, Blaise, Catherine of Alexandria, Christopher, Cyriacus the Martyr, Denis of Paris, Erasmus, Eustachius, George, Giles, Margaret of Antioch, Pantaleon, Vitus.

August 9 – **Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross** (Edith Stein), Carmelite, Religious, Martyr, co-patron of Europe

August 10 – **Saint Lawrence of Rome**, Deacon, Martyr, Patron of cooks, paupers, archivists and librarians

August 11 – **Saint Clare of Assisi**, founder of the Order of Poor Ladies (Poor Clares), Patron of television, communications

August 12 – **Sainte Jeanne France de Chantal**, wife and mother, founder of the Congregation of the Visitation of Our Lady (Visitationists) for lay women who did not wish the full life of the orders

Saturday, August 6 - Feast - THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

This is one of two Christocentric Gospels events of theophany that mark the explicit presence of all three persons of the Blessed Trinity. We see the foreshadowing of the Jesus in the Tabernacle: it takes us back to the Tabernacle where Jesus resides on earth. We do not see His glory here on earth, but we look forward to heaven when the veil will be removed and we enjoy the beatific vision of God.
