

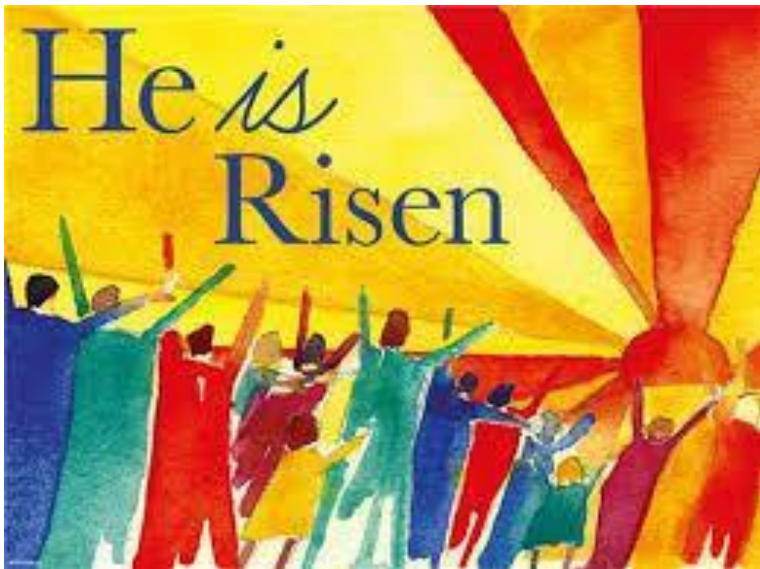

ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

GOOD FRIDAY IS A DAY OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE.

Good Friday and Holy Saturday are days of prayer and quiet reflection as we honour the suffering and death of Jesus and prepare to share in the resurrection at Easter.

April 16 – **Saint Benoit (Benedict) Labre**, perpetual pilgrim for Christ spending his life in continual prayer and sacrifice as a wayfarer from one shrine to the next, lived off alms, Patron of beggars, hoboes and tramps, homeless people, mentally ill people, people rejected by religious orders, pilgrims, unmarried men

April 17 - **Saint Kateri Tekakwitha**, known for her spirituality and austere lifestyle, miracle worker, her grave became a pilgrimage site and place of miracles for Christian Native Americans and French colonists, first Native American proposed for canonization, known as Lily of the Mohawks, Patroness of Canada and Native Americans, a saint for those persecuted for piety

April 18 – **Blessed Marie-Anne Blondin**, religious, foundress of the Sisters of Sainte Anne, a teaching religious congregation "for the education of poor country children, both girls and boys in the same schools"

April 21 – **Saint Anselm of Canterbury**, Benedictine monk, Archbishop of Canterbury, Doctor of the Church for Scholasticism and a Marian Doctor, called "Magnificent doctor" (*Doctor magnificus*), one of the great philosophers and theologians of the middle-ages and a noted theological writer.

Until next Sunday, April 24, you may donate items for newly arrived women and children by dropping them off at the Corpus Christi Parish Hall. They will be collected and brought to the Donation Centre organised by St-Sophie Ukrainian Orthodox Cathedral in Montreal. They request **new items only** (preferably in the package, no used clothing or supplies):

- Babies clothing;
- Diapers; Wipes; Baby Food in jar (carrots, beans cereal); Formula; Blankets; Pacifiers; Face cloths;
- NEW stuffed animals or small games; Coloring books and crayons;
- Children and Women: Socks and Underwear;
- Hygiene products: Shampoo; Deodorant; Sanitary napkins; Toothbrush; Toothpaste;
- Medical Supplies: Tourniquet, First Aid Kit, Polysporin, Military Survival Kit, Alcohol Pads, Peroxide, etc...
- Army Supplies: Walkie Talkies; Sleeping bags; Flashlights (LED)
