Now that the public health state of emergency has been lifted in Quebec, and in order to remove all doubt in the conscience of the faithful, the **Diocesan Dispensation from Sunday Mass is ended. Corpus Christi will continue to livestream the Sunday Masses, 10am and 3pm** to allow those who cannot leave their homes due of illness, disease, physical or psychological disability or other "grave cause" or because they are responsible for caring for someone who cannot, to fulfill their obligation to "Keep holy the Sabbath" by providing a means to spend time in prayer with the parish community. Powerful Prayer and Witness

Please join fellow parishioners, family and friends this **Saturday, July 2, 9 am, to pray the First Saturday Rosary Devotion to Our Lady of Fatima.**

This devotion is a response to the request of Our Blessed Mother in her appearances at Fatima in 1917. During the third apparition on July 13, Our Lady asked the children for the Five First Saturdays to be remembered and the Rosary to be prayed for the five kinds of offenses and blasphemies committed against her Immaculate Heart.



ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

July is dedicated to the Blood of Christ

Shed for us, it now pulses through his Mystical Body, and continues its salvific work, preserving and purifying, repairing and providing nourishment for regeneration and renewal of its members.

June 26 – **Saint Josemaría Escrivá de Balaguer y Albas**, priest, founder of Opus Dei and the Priestly Society of the Holy Cross

June 27 – **Saint Cyril of Alexandria**, Bishop, Doctor of the Church, Doctor of the Incarnation, opponent of Nestorianism, made key contributions to Christology (held that the relationship between the divine and the human in Christ was so closely united that the Virgin was actually Theotokos, Mother of God)

June 27 – **Blessed Nykyta Budka**, Bishop for Ukrainian Catholics in Canada, Martyr and **Blessed Vasyl Velychkowsky**, Redemptorist, Ukrainian Catholic Bishop, Martyr

June 27 – **Our Lady of Perpetual Succour/Help**, “The Madonna of Saint Matthew”, National Patroness of the Republic of Haiti

June 28 – **Saint Irenaeus**, Bishop, Martyr,

June 29 – **Saints Peter and Paul**, Apostles

Saint Peter is the patron of fishermen, net makers, and ship builders, Saint Paul is the patron of authors, the press, publishers, and writers, will intercede especially for guidance in following Christ’s teachings, for help in leading someone to the faith, or for courage when faced with opposition

June 30 – **The First Martyrs of the Holy Roman Church/ the See of Rome**, dedicated to the Christians martyred under the emperor Nero



Friday, July 1 – CANADA DAY

Canadians should seek to be witnesses to Christ in Canada and the world, and to continue working to influence those in government to act from Christian principles and attitudes. Christians, realizing they do not have a lasting home here, should pray and work for justice and peace in Canada and throughout the world, so that all God’s people may share in the goods of this earth. God’s kingdom will come only when all people are ready to let Christ’s teaching guide and rule their lives and actions. – CCCB, ORDO
