

Make Room for Peace (cf. John 14:27)
March 7-10, 2026

Preached by Fr. Anthony Atansi
Chaplain of the Newman Centre and Professor of Theology, McGill University

A filled and busy life... anxious mind... troubled heart... restive body... hurting spirit... dark imaginations... tensed and broken relationships...

This is what life looks like for many of us in a fast-paced society with an endless list of changes, chances, and challenges.

But is it meant to be so? Is that how life ought to be lived, with so much diseases? Is that God's purpose for us? Is that His design for our world or are we simply setting ourselves up for nothing?

Can we do something about it so as to reconnect with the depth of living the life that God desires for us? We believe we can, by making room for peace – “the peace the world cannot give.” That's the peace the Holy Spirit desires to gift us this Lent and always.

Join us in this year's Lenten mission at St. Veronica's Parish in Dorval, to explore how to make room for that peace within ourselves, in our relationship with others and with God.

Fr. Anthony will preach
at the weekend Masses, March 7 & 8, Sat.: 4.30 pm, Sun.: 9 am and 11 am;
and give two meditations on Monday and Tuesday evening at 7 pm.

Double up Sunday – next week, March 7-8



ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

February is devoted to the Holy Family

The month of March is dedicated to Saint Joseph, spouse of the Blessed Virgin

Mary and foster-father to Jesus. His feast day is on March 19 and is usually the only Solemnity celebrated in the Lenten season.

March 4 – **Saint Casimir**, Polish Prince, Grand-Duke of Lithuania, lived a highly disciplined, even severe life, sleeping on the ground, spending a great part of the night in prayer, dedicating himself to lifelong celibacy, he had a great devotion to Mary, supported the poor, and lived a virtuous life amid the dissolute court, Patron saint of Lithuania and one of the patrons of Poland

March 4 – **Saint Non (Nonna, Nonnita)**, [unwed] mother of Saint David, Patron of religious in convents in Wales, Cornwall, and Brittany.

Friday, March 6 – **WORLD DAY OF PRAYER**, Informed Prayer and Prayerful Action Invites Christians to pause and pray together ecumenically, recalling our Christian responsibility to be sensitive to the signs of the times so that we might bring a more authentically Christian dimension to the concerns of our world, our country, our community. Sponsored by the Women's Inter-Church council of Canada and its national counterparts around the world, it is celebrated in approximately 165 countries. <https://wdpcanada.ca/>

March 7 – **Saints Perpetua and Felicity**, a noblewoman & her slave, Martyred as catechumens and pregnant during the persecution of Christians by Emperor Severus
