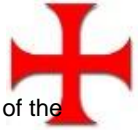

ON THE LITURGICAL CALENDAR

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they also look to the present and the future, and give us an insight into our own relationship with God.

April 23 – **Saint George**, Martyr, immortalised in the story of the Saint and the drago, one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers, Patron of England and many other countries and cities, the Boy Scouts, knights and soldiers



April 23 – **Saint Adalbert of Prague**, Benedictine, Bishop, Martyr, Apostle of the Slavs, Patron of Bohemia, Czech Republic, Poland and Prague

April 24 – **Saint Fidelis of Sigmaringen**, Capuchin Franciscan friar, Martyr, preacher, Patron of lawyers

April 25 – **Saint Mark, Evangelist**, author of the earliest and shortest gospel, often depicted with a winged lion, patron of notaries, Egypt and Venice

April 26 – **Our Lady of Good Counsel**, Patron of the C.W.L. of Canada

April 27 – **Saint Zita**, domestic servant, generously gave her own food and sometimes that of her master, to those poorer than herself, Patron of: housekeeping, against losing keys, domestic servants, people ridiculed for their piety, rape victims, single laywomen, waitstaff

April 28 – **Saint Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort**, Priest, Dominican, founded the Daughters of Divine Wisdom, the Brothers of Saint Gabriel, and the Company of Mary (Montfort Missionaries), one of the greatest apostles of the Rosary, devoted to Total Consecration to the Blessed Virgin as a perfect manner of renewing one's baptismal promises, wrote *The Secret of the Rosary*, and *True Devotion to Mary*

April 28 – **Saint Gianna Beretta Molla**, mother of four, pediatrician, risked her own health for her baby's in the womb

April 29 – **Saint Catherine of Sienna**, Dominican Tertiary, O.P. (Consecrated virgin), Mystic, Doctor of the Church, Doctor of Unity, Scholastic philosopher and theologian, her godly wisdom influenced popes, nobles and commoners alike, co-patron of Europe (with Saints Benedict, Bridget of Sweden, Cyril and Methodius, and Teresa Benedicta of the Cross)

April 24-30 – **National Volunteer Week**

2022 Theme: **“Volunteering is Empathy in Action;
Volunteers Bring Heart to Canada’s Communities”**

People are encouraged to thank the thousands of volunteers across the country whose empathy, compassion and generosity create connections and build a stronger Canada. It's also a time to consider volunteering, and/or of providing other support to those organizations vital to your community.

Sunday April 24 – **anniversary of the Armenian Genocide**

Monday, April 25 – **Major Rogation Day**, a day of prayer and abstinence, offering prayers to the Lord for the needs of all people, especially for the productivity of the earth and human labour, and to make public thanksgiving during the spring planting season, asking for God's protection from calamities, and invoking blessings on the harvest, It used to be traditional for the congregation to walk in procession around the boundaries of the parish on the major rogation day, blessing every tree, stone and crop, while chanting or reciting a Litany of Mercy, usually a Litany of the Saints."
